I am a Christian, our Lord is risen Blow the trumpets, my brethren He is the Messiah, Jehovah Jirah King of kings and Lord of lords


I am a Christian; I'll wear your armor and fight for you like a brave soldier, Will never be wishy-washy, I promise; Before you I bow, my Jesus.






